ORDINANCE #2021- O -12-2

ORDINANCE AMENDING EXEMPTIONS FROM CERTAIN REGULATIONS FOR SHORT-TERM RENTALS

WHEREAS, the Town of Brighton ("Town") Town Council ("Council") previously enacted an ordinance regulating short-term rentals on property within the Town; and

WHEREAS, short-term rental units located within multi-family structures and subject to the approved Master Plan in Solitude Village were approved for short term rentals land use approval; and

WHEREAS, the properties in Solitdue Village which are located within the Solitude Village Master Association require fewer regulations due to the Master Association existing regulations and resort purpose of Solitude Village;

WHEREAS, Property within the Solitude Village Master Association has internal regulations and enforcement through home owners associations and security officers on staff to minimize impacts of short term rentals for properties located within the Solitude Village Master Association;

WHEREAS, the Solitude Village Master Association Properties are defined, as recorded with the Salt Lake County Recorder on May 5, 1999, Entry # 7344959, Book 8274, Pages 8334-8415.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF BRIGHTON TOWN COUNCIL OF, UTAH, THAT:

<u>SECTION I</u>: Title 5 Business Licenses and Regulations, Chapter 19 Short Term Rentals, Section 084 is amended to as follows:

5.19.084 Exemption From Certain Regulations For Short-Term Rentals In Multi-Family Units or properties within the at Solitude Village Master Association.

Short-term rentals units located within multi-family buildings (5 or more dwelling units)located in the Solitude Village Master Association Approved Master Planned area_are exempt from a permitted land use permit for short term rental use and the following sections of this Chapter:

- 1. 5.19.065 Minimum Rental Period of Two Nights
- 2. 5.19.070 Maintenance—Structures and grounds
- 3. 5.19.075 Parking and Parking Areas

- 4. 5.19.080 Interior signage.
- 5. 5.19.083 Required communication with Renters

Section II: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication.
